Dear Parent/Carer

I hope this letter finds you and your family well. I would like to thank you for all the support you have given the academy and your child over the last year during what have proved to be very unusual circumstances.

You will be aware that Year 11 remain on our roll until the last Friday of June. That said, I am writing to inform you that the last day of formal education for Year 11 will be **Friday 28th May**.

In order to continue to support our students in preparation for the next stage of education and/or training we will continue to offer onsite and remote sessions. This will not be a full timetable but will cover careers advice and guidance and in addition we aim to provide some 'bridging' lessons for students who are taking A levels in September.

Bridging lessons will take place on site and students who choose to attend will be required to do so in full uniform and will sign in and out of the academy. Individual members of staff will be discussing these sessions with students as appropriate and a timetable of sessions will be published.

Careers advice and guidance will be delivered by Google Classroom and students will receive invites.

Any students who received welfare calls during the lockdown will continue to receive them after half term up until the end of June.

On Friday 28th May students should attend in full uniform and the programme of the day will be lessons as normal periods 1 and 2, period 3 there will be a leavers' assembly for students and students may leave at 12 noon.

In addition, in the afternoon, students may remain as we have planned some activities and catering until 2.00 pm.

Students wishing to remain for the afternoon must do so and should not leave and come back. Whilst we would love to see all of our students unfortunately those who fail to meet our expectations from this point with regards to conduct will not qualify to attend this reward activity. Should students wish to change into PE kit for the afternoon they may do so and if students wish to bring their own decorated shirt for signing in the afternoon they may do so.


